PROOF OF VACCINATION

Proof of vaccination must be submitted for each attendee, speaker and vendor. Advisers can help each student create a CrowdPass account, but advisers cannot upload student health data from the adviser's account. CrowdPass can be accessed through a desktop browser or mobile device.

Step 1

Take a photo or scan your COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card to the device you will use to create a CrowdPass account.

Step 2

Click on the Submit Vaccine link on the convention website or registration progress email, or scan the QR code below.

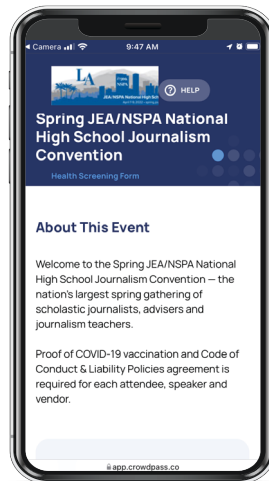


Step 3

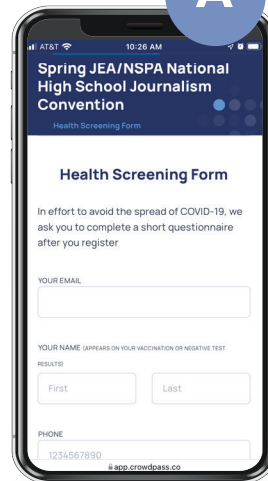
Follow the prompts and complete the necessary information: Health Screening Form (A), Event Waiver and Release Claims agreement (B), and COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card upload (C).

Information submitted for attendees must match the information given at online registration. Legal name, phone number, email address and date of birth are collected for verification purposes and will not be added to any convention database.

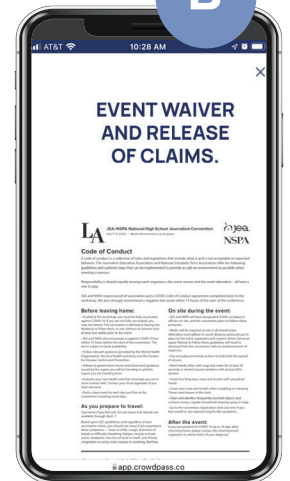
Advisers will be notified of student attendees missing approval.



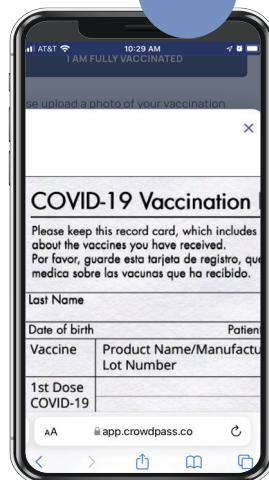

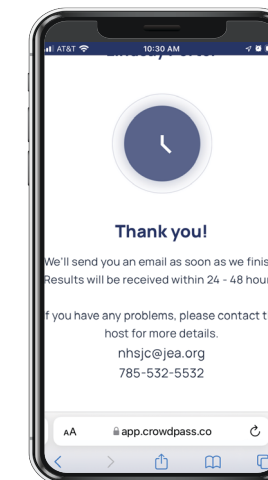
Health Screening Form personal information
