His first viral video was when he counted to 100,000 in 24 hours, and as of 2021, it had 24,691,790 views. Slowly, his channel got very popular and was most known for doing challenges and giving things away to those in need, as well as other people. You may have heard of Team Trees and Team Seas, and many people are donating to both funds to save the environment and to support Mr. Beast as well.

Markiplier, like Mr. Beast, started out with doing Let's Play videos, and he started his channel when he was only 12 years old, (like many of the people reading this article). He mainly did horror games and Indie Games, which are independent games. In 2018, he took a break from YouTube when his step-niece was killed in a car accident at 19 years old. He also made a YouTube Original called A Heist with Markiplier, a choose your own adventure special. As of 2021, he had almost 30 million subscribers. He also donates to charities, donating 3 million dollars in total to various charities.

DanTDM was known before as The Diamond Minecart, starting in 2012. He does game content and mostly does Minecraft, and is one of the most popular YouTubers, and does well as he is a middle child in his family. He had 3 million subscribers as of 2021. Also, he had managed to get the Guinness World Record for teams of both 2 and 3 and is most famous for his Let's Plays.

These three YouTubers show that if you spend time and effort on something you enjoy doing and if you do your best, you can create something that can make a difference. This is good advice on how to decide what to make for your own YouTube channel but also for life.
