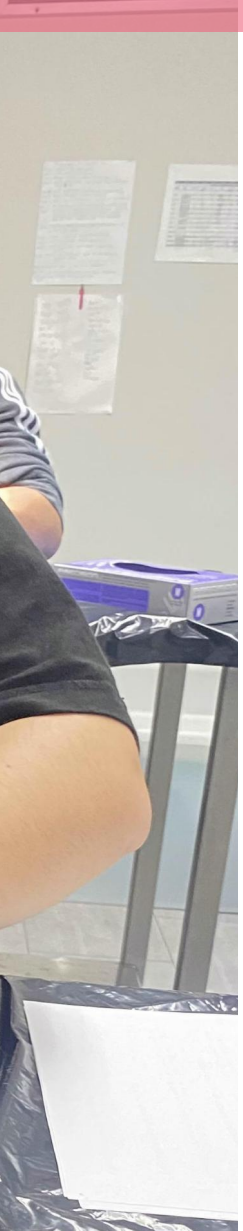
Oh Shoot!

Eli Fernandez, '23 Avoiding a shot from his opponent, Eli is trying to crank his ankle and secure a C.I.F. win in his biggest moment.

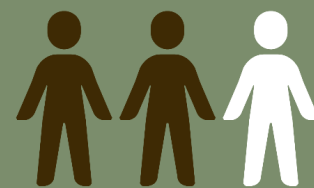
Brandon Gomez, '23 Gomez is fighting against his opponent's attempt of a double leg, looking to get a reversal and even a pin.

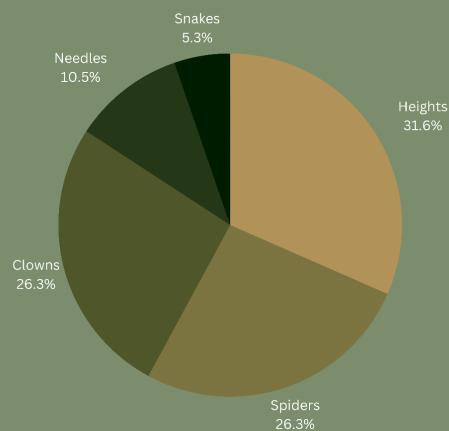

AP Environmental Science students share their opinions

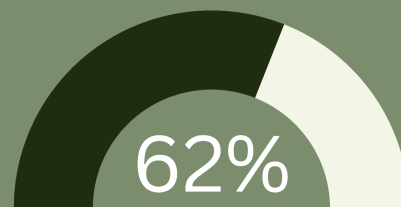


Two out of three students would explore space rather than the ocean.
