

The phone call

McElroy said she recieved a call from Interim Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences José Luis Bermúdez, warning her that her hiring, "stirred up a hornet's nest" and stating people could force leadership to fire her.



McElroy said she recieved a second one-year contract separate from the offer that she verbally agreed to. The offer included mention of "at-will" termination.



Bermúdez steps down

Bermúdez sent an email of resignation to students and faculty "in light of controversy surrounding recent communications with Dr. Kathleen McElroy."



Media uproar

The Texas Tribune broke the news about McElroy returning to faculty at the University of Texas.



Faculty Senate meeting

President Banks said the president's office was unaware of any contract revisions and the first contract was never revoked.
