ETHAN YAVITZ'S (12) CAR CATCHES FIRE IN STUDENT PARKING LOT NOV. 6

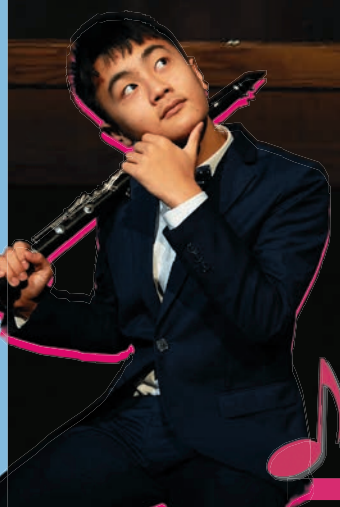

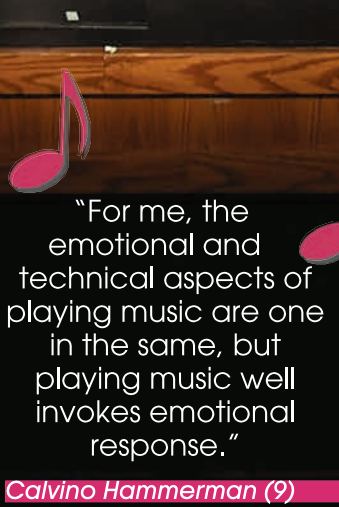
