Innovation Pacemaker Entry Daily Nebraskan (University of Nebraska-Lincoln)

Summary:

 Press Play is a live concert by a local band in the DN office, coupled with a feature story on the local band. It's a combined effort between the Culture and Multimedia sections.

Goals:

- Give reporters hands-on experience with cross-media journalism and storytelling
- Strengthen our connection to community actors and organizations
- Innovate cross-platform content by merging video with social and written digital.
- Have fun and connect with our peers!

Elements:

- Video released on YouTube of the full concert
- Photo and video content of the band before the concert
- Feature story on the band
- Promotional content on social media to accompany the YouTube release

Details:

- Press Play is a live concert in the Daily Nebraskan office performed by a local Lincoln-based band, recorded, edited and produced by our Multimedia team of video editors. Our Culture team of local music reporters finds the bands, then does a feature story on the band to accompany each concert video. It grows both our reporters' connections to the community and each other.
- Press Play 2025 was a revival of the idea from the early 2010s. It emerged from the love and excitement our Culture and Multimedia teams experienced

- covering local Lincoln music festivals and a desire to give the newsroom something fun to unite them.
- This year, the DN welcomed 6 different local bands to perform: The Vix,
 Joyrager, JDreams the Alien and Friends, Jet Set, Groove Lagoon and Hold
 Your Breath.

How it's done:

- A member of the Culture team selects a band to reach out to. They develop a connection and get contact information for the band. They coordinate interviews for the profile piece and times for recording.
- A member of the Culture staff does the interviewing and collects footage and photos of the band, writes and edits the feature story.
- The band comes into the office and performs. While reporters enjoy the concert in the office, the Multimedia team is hard at work integrating the band's equipment with video and audio equipment.
- Our team of video editors puts together the final product and publishes it on social media channels, primarily YouTube. The Digital team works to promote it across other platforms.

Impact:

- Press Play has increased our engagement on social media and on the web.
 On average, Press Play videos garnered around 400 views, a dramatic increase from our channel average of 75.
- Press Play dramatically increased the DN's connection to the local music scene. Moving beyond concert photo galleries and reviews, viewers were offered the opportunity to experience the band for themselves. Several bands volunteered for future DN community events— one band lead singer even cut one of our reporters' hair in the office.
- Press Play united multiple teams in our newsroom. It created a space for community and connection across sections, fostering collaboration between reporters who started two weeks and two years ago. It got people in the office for something fun and exciting that mattered to them.
