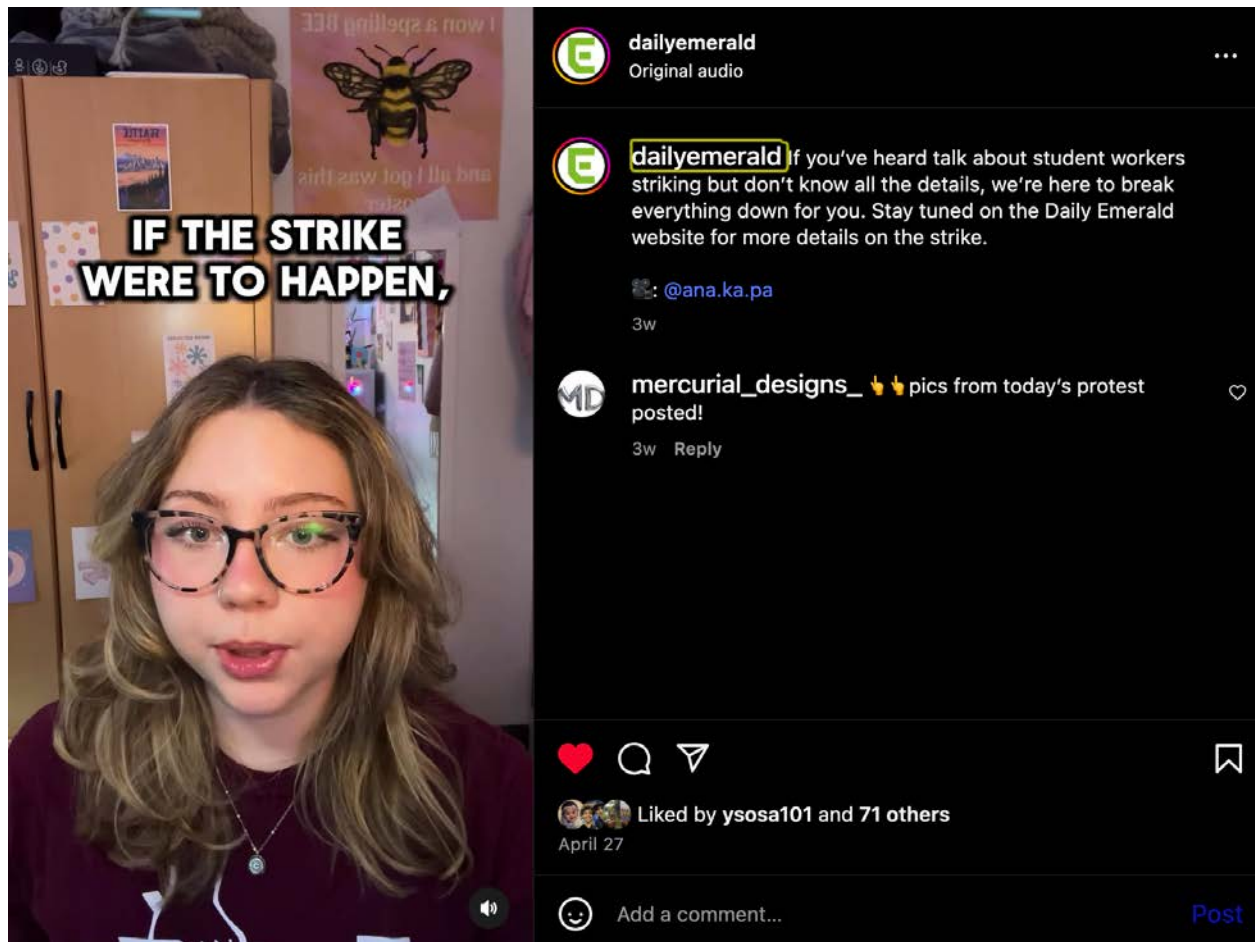

UOSW to strike tomorrow morning

UO Student Workers are set to begin picketing on April 28 at 8 a.m.

dailyemerald The University of Oregon Student Workers Union will strike tomorrow, April 28, according to an email sent by Angela Lauer Chong, vice president for student life. The union represents over 4,000 students.

The announcement comes after nearly 11 months of bargaining, where both the UO administration and the union could not reach an agreement.

"We respect the right of UOSW-represented student employees to conduct a legal strike and continue negotiating toward a fair and reasonable agreement," Chong said.

Picket lines are currently set up in front of Johnson Hall.

During the strike, dining halls, mailing and package services will continue to operate, though dining hall hours may differ. Changes in hours of operations will be updated at each dining venue.

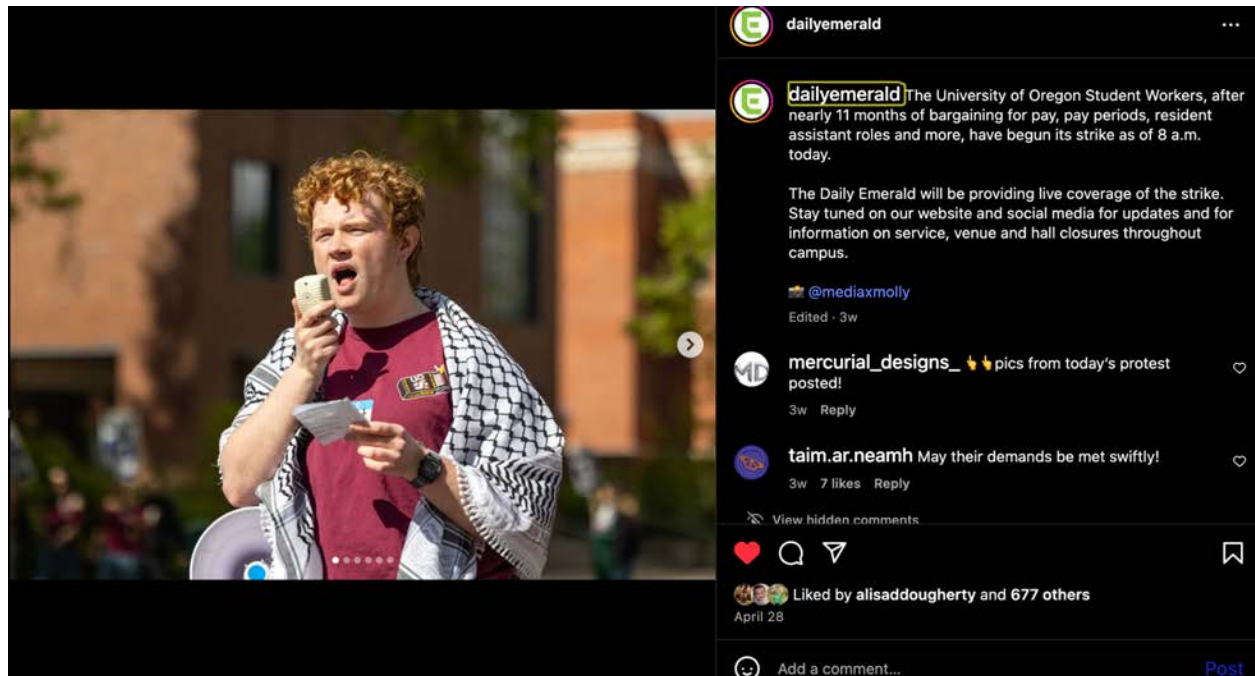

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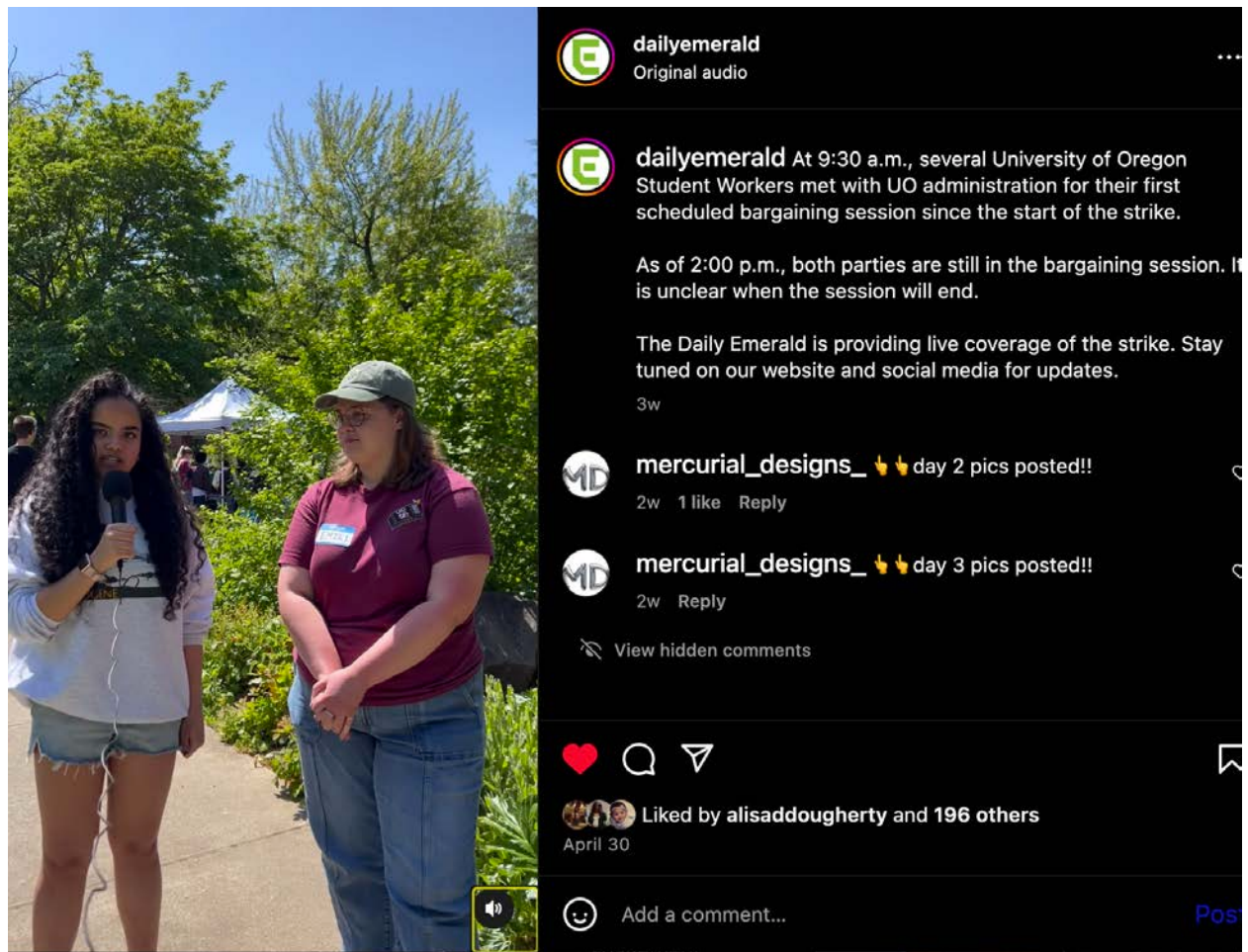

UO to review, possibly take legal action against UOSW “disruptions”

An email sent by Provost Christopher Long said that UO is actively reviewing actions taken by UOSW during its strike. UO said it could take legal or disciplinary action.

dailymerald In an email sent to UO employees, Provost and Senior Vice President Christopher Long and Mark Schmelz, vice president and chief human resource officer, said that protest activities by the University of Oregon Student Workers Union “disrupted three important university events.”

Long said that UO is actively reviewing these disruptions and could take “possible legal and disciplinary action.”

Long mentioned that the two private events that were “disrupted” were the Division of Equity and Inclusion and The Office of Human Resources event about employee engagement on April 29, and an admissions event for college preparation for high school students from underrepresented backgrounds on May 2.

The third public event that was “disrupted” was a “Conversation on Democracy’s Future,” hosted by the School of Global Studies and Languages and Department of Political Science, which held faculty from Stanford University and members of the public on May 1.

Two dozen police officers leave after clearing student workers from Johnson Hall

The student workers entered the building sometime before 5:30 p.m. Police presence in and around Johnson Hall built to nearly two dozen police officers by 10:40 p.m.

After a presence of nearly two dozen UOPD and EPD officers around Johnson Hall this evening, UOPD police cars have vacated the scene. Roughly 250 striking workers and picketers are rallying behind Johnson Hall, hugging and cheering.

Just minutes before, police officers marched toward students who were occupying the building outside, and they were met with chanting from picketers and student workers outside.

Beginning at around 8:00 p.m., 60 striking student workers began occupying Johnson Hall.

Student workers have been inside the building most of the day since a scheduled sit-in began, according to Victoria Robison, a media liaison for UOSW.

The sit-in was expected to end before the building closed at 5:30 p.m., according to Robison, but some students remained in the building upon closure.

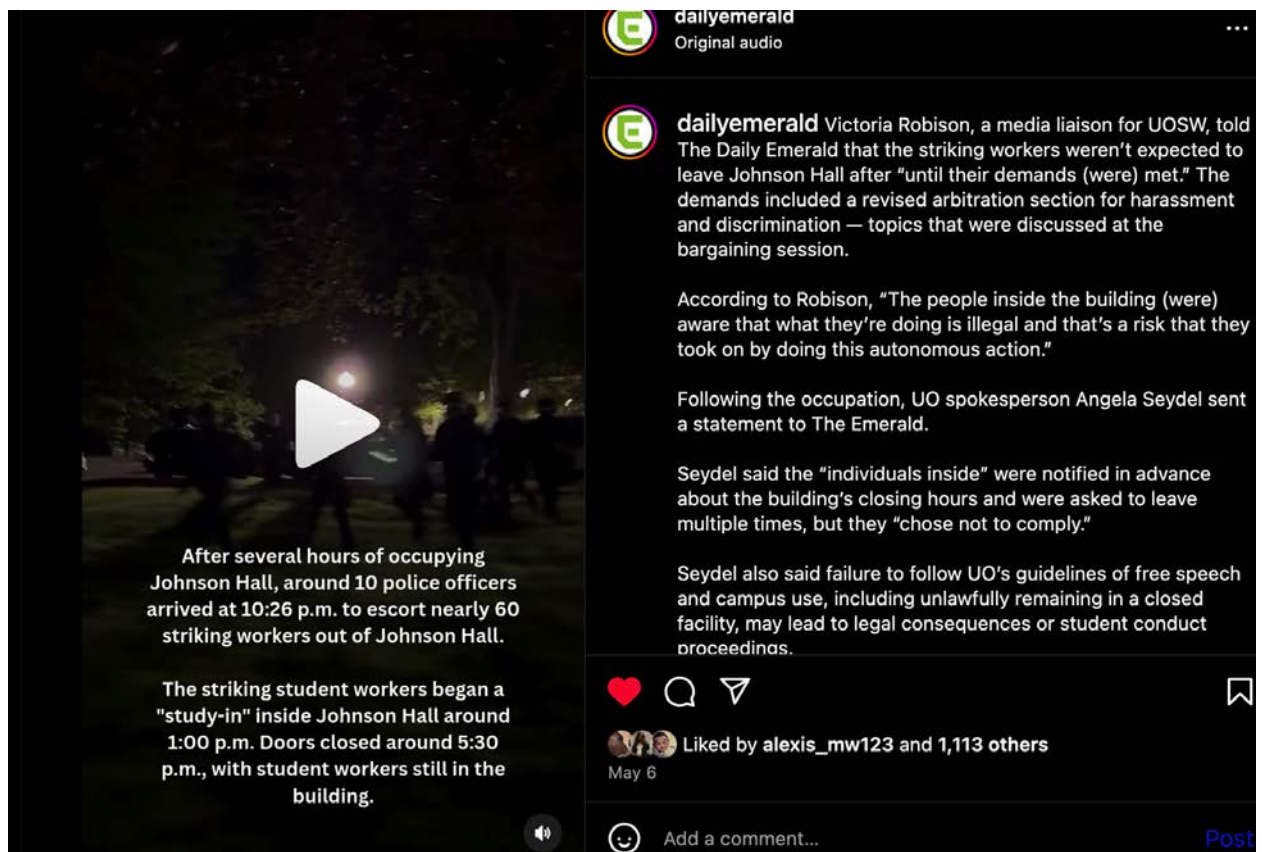

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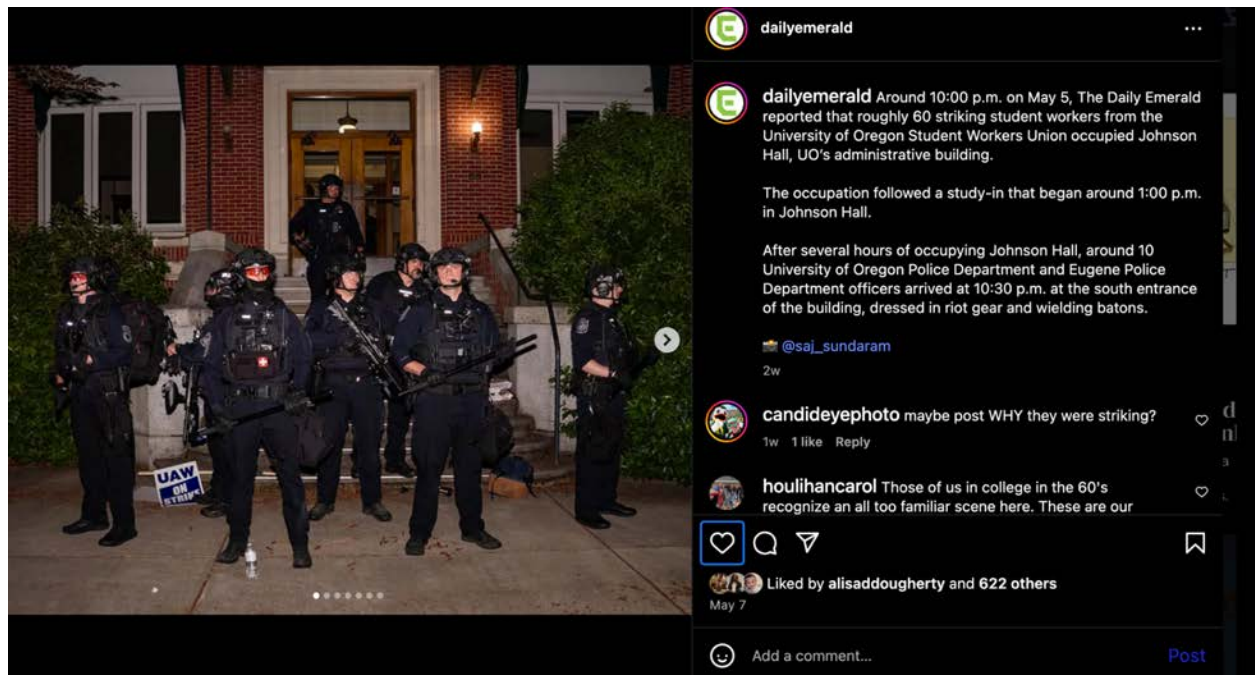
