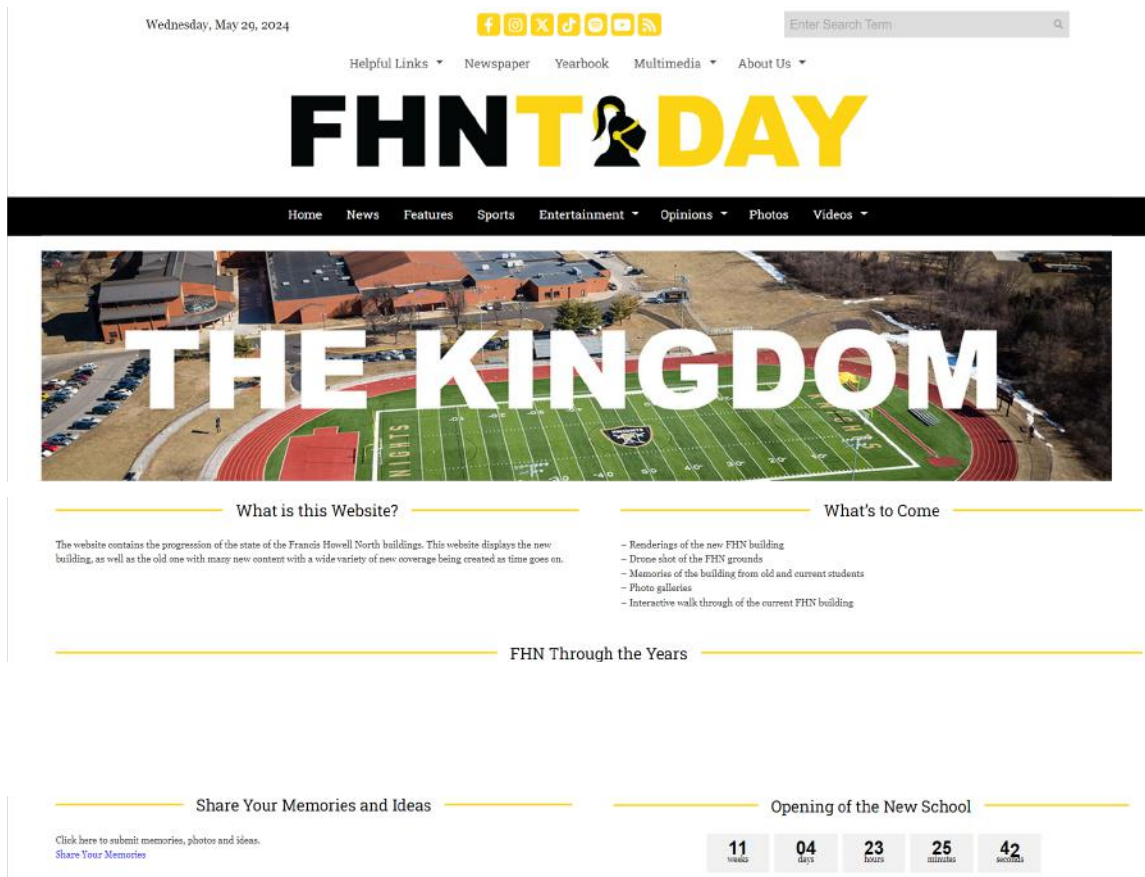

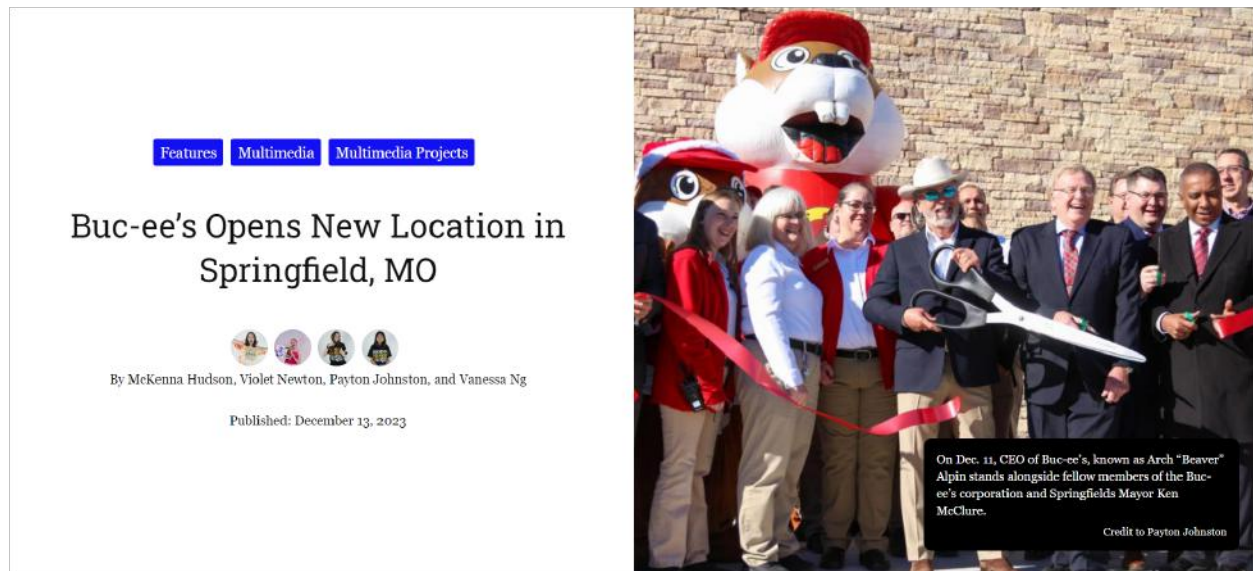
## Entry #1 - The Kingdom

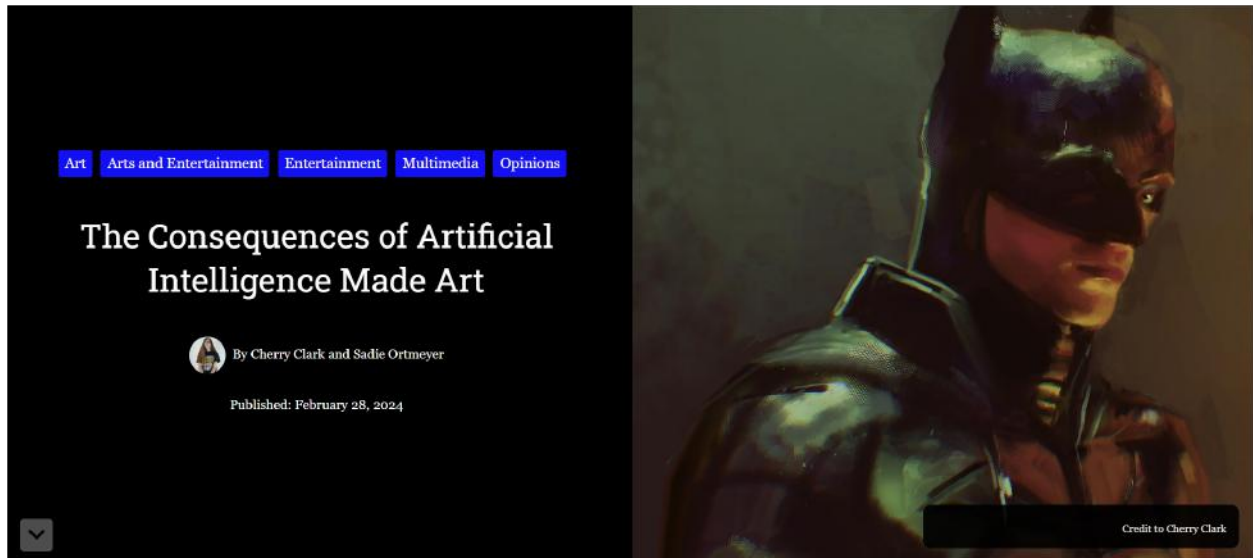
## Entry #3 - Maui Wildfires
