





The Kalven Report

In the politically turbulent 1960s the University of Chicago president appointed a committee to define the role of the university in terms of "political and social action." The committee, chaired by law professor Harry Kalven Jr., determined that most political statements – with a few exceptions – made by any University of Chicago department or unit could undermine the diverse perspectives of individuals and exclude minority views. The findings, known as the Kalven report, formalize the university's neutrality in political matters. Land Acknowledgement In 2021, the Laboratory Schools science department decided to create a land acknowledgement statement. Given the history of science largely excluding non-Western philosophies, members of the department said they saw value in having a land acknowledgement statement which

 land acknowledgement statement which was included along with their own statements about diversity, equity and inclusion and climate change, found in syllabuses. Land acknowledgements are formal expressions of recognition for Indigenous peoples who preceded European colonizers.

The University's Choice


After the science department's land acknowledgment was brought to the university administrators' attention, they notified Laboratory Schools Director Tori Jueds that such a statement was in conflict with the Kalven report. M. Jueds informed the U-High faculty of this at the Oct. 4 faculty meeting, explaining why the university made this decision, emphasizing that individuals can still express their opinions, like including personal land acknowledgment statements in their syllabi. Before it was removed, the science department's statement acknowledged the Ojibwe, Odawa, Potawatomi and other Indigenous peoples.
