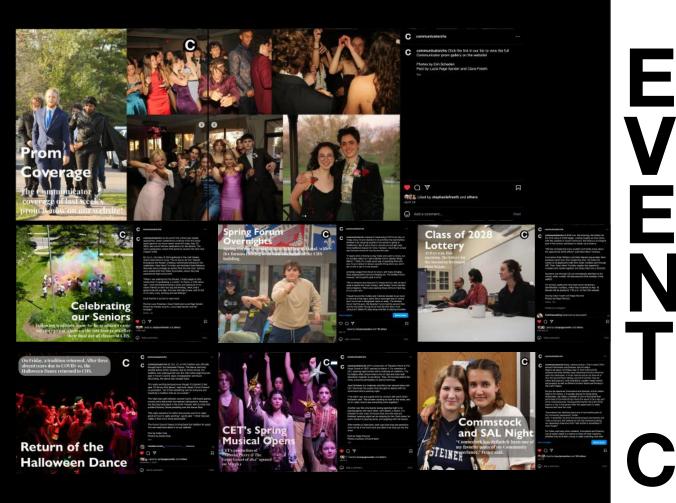

From our Halloween Dance to Community Ensemble Theater's Spring Musical to Prom, every key school event is covered by @CommunicatorCHS.

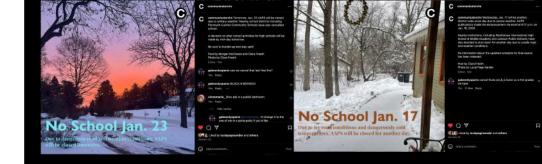

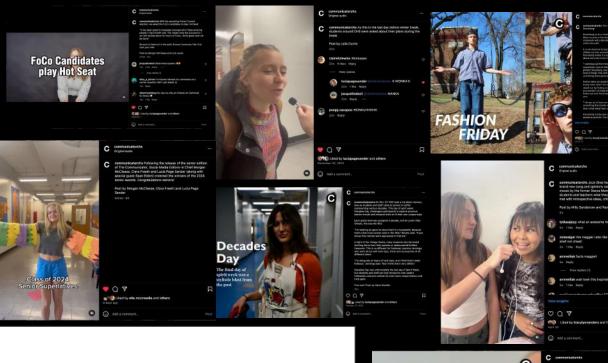

This spring, our district is facing a \$25 million budget deficit and its effects. The Communicator committed to doing what no other news source did by publishing live updates throughout numerous crucial school board meetings to keep the community informed in real time.



With four separate school cancellations affecting our Semester One finals schedule, it was crucial for us to relay all scheduling updates as expeditiously as possible. To achieve this, our EIC team was in contact with school leadership and each other right up until the final decision was called. As a result, for all four snow/cold days this year, the longest it took The Communicator to post was 8 minutes after the official cancellation announcement.

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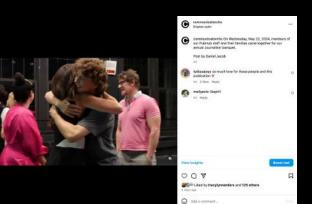

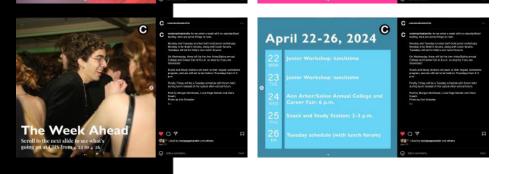
