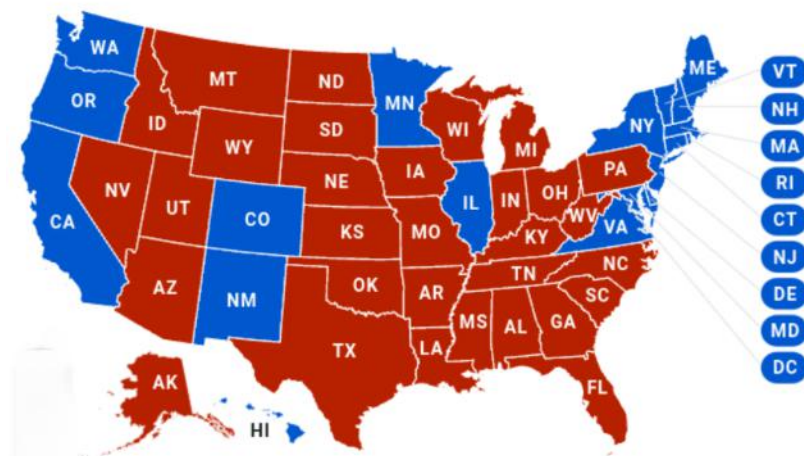




turn up the VOTES

After being 49th vice president, 60 year old Democrat, **Kamala Harris** entered the 2024 presidential election. Harris's proposal included plans for a ban on price gouging for groceries and food, eliminating medical debt, and a \$25,000 subsidy for first-time home buyers. **Harris** selected Tim Walz as her running mate. She became more widely known when she sought the party's nomination for the 2020 presidential election but withdrew from the race in 2019, due to a lack of funds. **Harris** is the first nominee who did not participate in the primaries since Vice President Hubert Humphrey in 1968. **Kamala Harris** lost the election with 226 votes compared to Donald Trump's 312 votes.



To win the presidential election, a candidate needs to reach 270 electoral votes. Every state has a certain amount of representatives; Kansas has six.

In 1845, a law passed by the US government, declared that election day will always land on the first Tuesday following the first Monday of November.

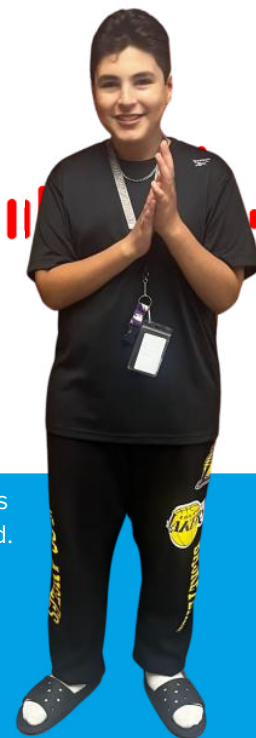


After the election against Joe Biden in 2020, **Donald Trump** returned to represent the Republican political party in the 2024 presidential election. One of **Trump's** goals is to improve multiple ongoing issues in the United States including his approach to reducing inflation for the US economy. He plans to charge tariffs, a tax on goods from foreign countries such as China, Japan, and Vietnam. He states that this will secure American jobs and provide support for the economy. In the 2020 election, **Trump** won the popular vote, with 56% of Kansans supporting him. Traditionally Kansas votes Republican, and this year was no different with all six electoral votes going towards **Trump's** victory. the 2024 presidential election. **Donald Trump** won the election after winning with 312 votes compared to Kamala Harris's 226.
