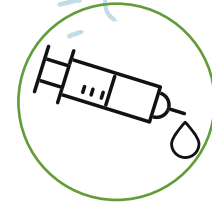

One two-dose vaccine, the Pfizer vaccine, has already received U.S. Food and Drug Administration approval. Emergency use authorizations have been granted to the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines.
