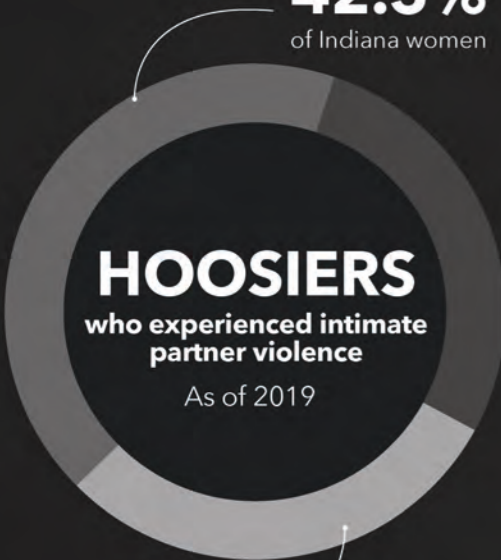


UNSPOKEN TRUTHS

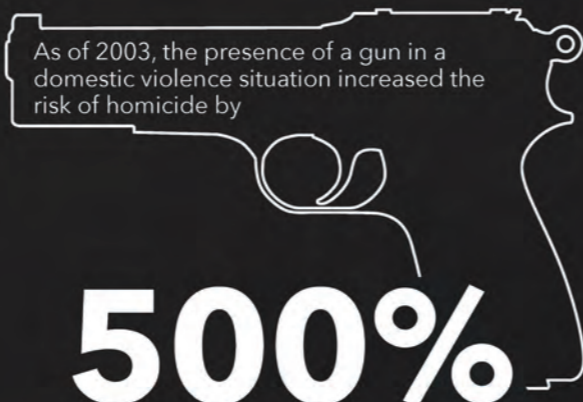
