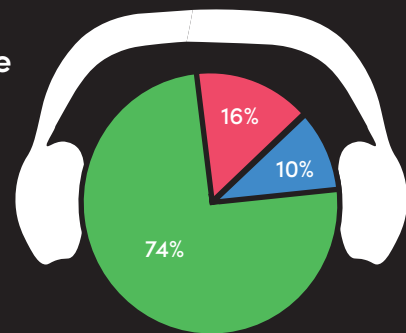

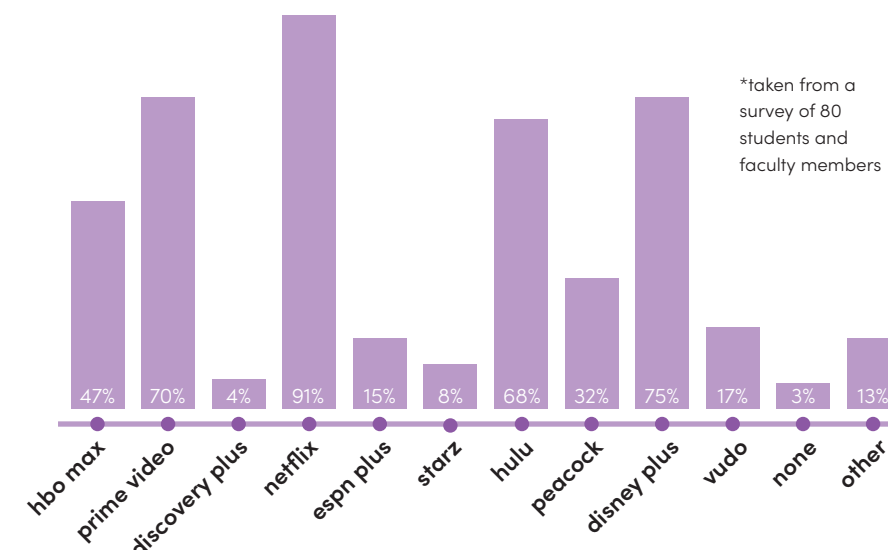

"I think they should let us have our phones. I am the type of person that can't get my work done unless I have music playing. I have to be focusing on more than one thing to be successful."

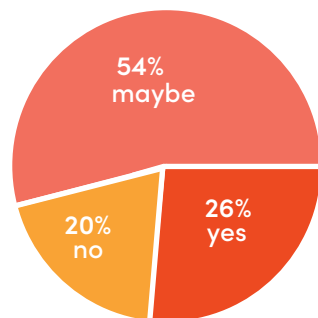

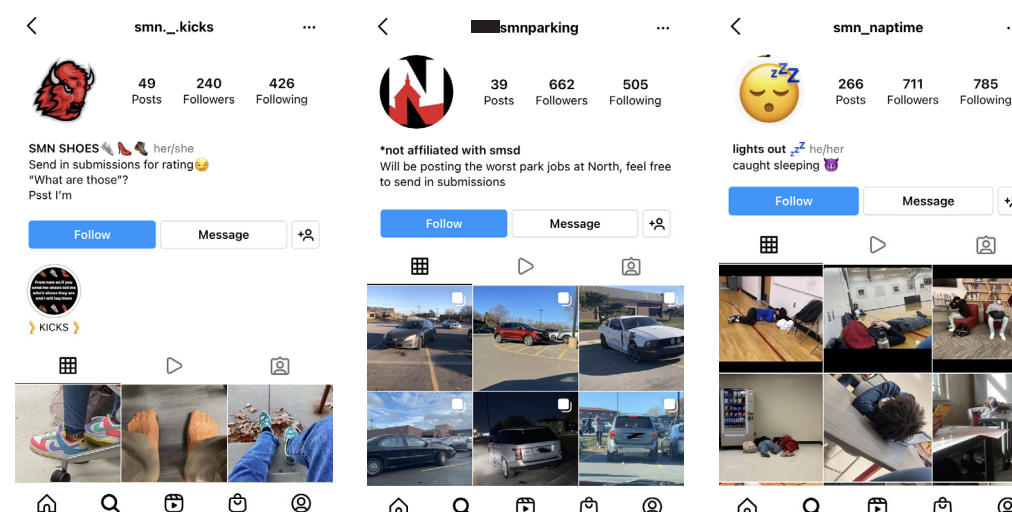
Do you think phones are a distraction to learning?
